HOW TO USE THIS ENTRY FORM:

- 1. Licensed Conformation classes consist of:
- A. Regular Classes. Classes for intact dogs: Puppy (6 mos., under 1 yr.); Junior (1 yr., under 2 yrs.); Intermediate (Senior) (2yrs., under 3 yrs.); Adult (3 yrs. and up); Breeder/Handler (6 mos. and up, handled by breeder or member of breeder's family); Champion; and Grand Champion.
- **B. Altered Classes. Classes for altered dogs.** Altered Puppy (6 mos., under 1 yr.); Altered Junior (1 yr., under 2 yrs.); Altered Intermediate (Senior) (2yrs., under 3 yrs.); Altered Adult (3 yrs. and up); Altered Breeder/Handler (6 mos. and up, handled by breeder or member of breeder's family); Altered Champion; and Altered Grand Champion.
- C. Junior Showmanship Classes. Consist of: Pee Wee (over 2 yrs., under 4 yrs.); Sub-Junior (4 yrs., under 6 yrs.); Pre-Junior (6 yrs., under 8); Novice Junior, Open Junior (8 yrs., under 13 yrs.); Novice Senior, Open Senior (13 yrs., up to & including 18 yrs.)
- All entries must be submitted on the current "Official UKC" Entry Form". You may use one entry form to enter the same dog in more than one activity on the same weekend.
- 3. Use a separate entry form for each dog entered in a club's event.
- 4. Mail all completed entry forms to the Event Secretary listed under the event, unless otherwise specified. Make checks payable to host club.
- 5. All UKC Performance events are open to any UKC registered dogs and dogs with a valid Limited Privilege/Performance Listing number, with the exception of Lure Coursing Tests and Regular Stakes. The Coursing Aptitude Test is open to all UKC registered dogs and dogs with a valid Limited Privilege/Performance Listing number.
- 6. We want you to keep the points earned at UKC Licensed events. Important things to remember:
 - Dog not UKC registered? Apply for a Temporary Listing Number (TL) online at www.ukcdogs.com or call the Dog Events Department at (269) 343-9020. (TL fees are non-refundable, non-transferable and do not apply to the cost of permanent registration.)
- All dogs entering UKC events must be permanently registered, have a valid Temporary Listing Number, or a Limited Privilege/Performance Listing number.
- All entry forms must be completed and signed. Incorrect information submitted on the entry form may invalidate your wins.
- To be eligible to enter into the Breeder/Handler class, you must be one of the breeders of record, or a member of the immediate family of one of the breeders of record. Immediate family includes: spouse, parent, step-parent, child, step-child, sibling, grandchild, or in-law, so long as the handler is not a professional handler as defined by UKC Rules and Regulations.

WAIVER

All events are held under the Official Rules and Regulations of the United Kennel Club, Inc. Absolutely no alcoholic beverages, illegal drugs or firearms will be allowed on the grounds or in the buildings on the day of a UKC Licensed event. UKC, its agents and employees, and the host club assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by spectators or by exhibitors and handlers, or to any of their dogs or property, and further assume no responsibility for injury to children not under the control of their parents or guardians. UKC and the host club are not responsible for loss, accidents or theft.

By signing this form, I hereby agree to waive any claim, action, or lawsuit and further agree to indemnify and hold UKC, the host club and any approved UKC Judge harmless from any claims, actions or lawsuits resulting from my participation in this event, and any action, decision or judgment made by any UKC or host club representative or approved Judge under the official UKC Rules and Regulations governing this event. I acknowledge that the current Official UKC Rules and Regulations (Agility, Conformation, Dock Jumping, Drag Race, Junior Showmanship, Lure Coursing, Obedience, Rally Obedience, Weight Pull) have been made available to me, and that I am familiar with their contents. My signature indicates that I understand and agree to the above and to abide by all of the current Official UKC Rules and Regulations.
